Worship Service: Come and Seek, Confirmation Class, Big House – 2nd Sunday of month 5:30pm-7pm

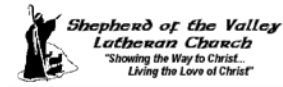

Confirmation Class: 3rd Sunday of month 5:30pm-7pm

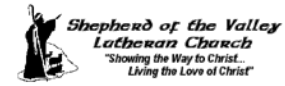

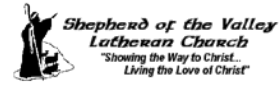

Overnight Mission Trip: City Reach - Boston, MA – Fri 5pm, Jan 16 – Sat 4:30pm, Jan 17

Description: The program starts on Friday evening and ends on the following Saturday afternoon. Participants arrive at Cathedral Church of St. Paul 7 pm Friday night, and are addressed by staff who are experiencing, or have experienced, homelessness. They walk through the city guided by members of common cathedral and end the evening with a simple worship service. Participants sleep upstairs in the sanctuary. On Saturday morning participants offer clothing that they have collected and a simple meal to unhoused guests who come to "shop" for clothing from among the donated items. Participants form teams for street outreach, taking sandwiches and clothes to people at South Station, Copley Square, Boston's waterfront and other sites. All then eat lunch and reflect together about their experiences in light of the Gospel, write a prayer, and talk about next steps for them personally and/or as a group.

Mission Trip: HS Mission Trip – Fri, June 19 - Mon, June 29 – Challenge Week – Navajo Reservation

Description: A camp not for the faint of heart...

Every summer, visitors from all over the world flock to this portion of the vast Navajo Reservation that straddles the Utah/Arizona state line. They come for the scenery that western movies are made of —sprawling desert vistas dotted with sagebrush, sweeping mesas, and fantastic colored monoliths in stone. A must-see tourist attraction is Four Corners, where Arizona, Utah, Colorado, and New Mexico come together.

While the scenery may be beautiful, life is hard here for people who call this dry, sprawling land home. What few jobs there are usually are low-paying and part-time. Vast distances require commuting, and vehicle accidents are common. Severe weather conditions join forces with poverty and overcrowding to wreak havoc on homes.

This will be a true Challenge experience in every sense of the word. Not only is it in a remote, undeveloped location where you will encounter third-world poverty—but the work will be challenging as well. Painting will be minimal, and only where it is critical to prolong the life of the house. You will focus instead on major projects like metal roofs and wheelchair ramps. Projects have been selected specifically to protect the structure of the home or provide for the physical safety of the resident. It's intense and meaningful work!

But don't worry if you lack construction skills—a team of local construction professionals who planned each project will be on hand to guide you every step of the way. Come to Red Mesa this summer and you'll work hard! You'll also see a landscape you'll never forget...experience a fascinating, centuries-old Native culture as an insider...and take home the satisfaction of having truly changed lives.

Description: From the sparkling three rivers that give Pittsburgh its edge to its landmark fountain at the point of it all, water brings life to the City of Bridges. Pittsburgh boasts the only state park in the country that’s located smack dab in the heart of a city. Newly renovated Point State Park—known to many locals simply as “The Point”—is a 36-acre green space right on the water’s edge, and it’s a perfect spot for recreation and relaxation after or during your week of service.

Despite the beauty of this city, thousands of children and adults don’t know where their next meal will come from—and Pittsburgh also has a large homeless population. It’s our privilege to partner with ministries and organizations committed to addressing these and other needs.

One of the very special places we serve is the Rainbow Kitchen, which provides a vital safety net for hungry children, struggling families, low-income elderly, ill and disabled individuals, the homeless, and growing numbers of people who are unemployed or among the working poor. Last year, Rainbow Kitchen provided more than 19,000 nutritious Kids Café dinner meals to low-income children at risk of hunger—and served an additional 18,000 substantial hot meals to breakfast program participants.
